

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF PEAK FOREST PARISH COUNCIL

TUESDAY 8th OCTOBER 2019.

726/2019 PRESENT.

Councillors Hopley (Chair), Denton and Noble attended the meeting. Borough Councillor Joanne Collins also attended the meeting.

727/2019 APOLOGIES. There were no apologies for absence.

728/2019 DECLARATIONS OF MEMBER INTEREST.

Resolved that Councillor Noble declared a personal interest in finance as her mother is the Clerk. Councillors Denton and Noble declared a personal interest in planning.

729/2019 MINUTES. Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on the 2nd September 2019 were a true and correct record. Councillor Hopley signed the minutes.

730/2019 PUBLIC SPEAKING. Borough Councillor Collins advised the Parish Council that there is to be a motion presented to High Peak Borough Council asking for a climate emergency to be declared. They want the Borough Council to agree to become carbon neutral by 2030. It will be difficult for the Council to have enough money to attain this.

731/2019 SPEEDING ISSUES.

From the road census which had been conducted it has shown that the average speeds through Peak Forest heading towards Tideswell is 39 mph and towards Sparrow Pit it is 35 mph. 4120 vehicles go through the village daily and 15% of that number are travelling at above 40 mph. 81 people travelled faster than 35 mph in a 2 ½ hour period. This information has been sent to CREST at Derbyshire Police.
